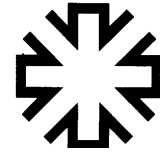

In this Sunday’s Gospel, Jesus and his disciples are approaching the city of Naim when they come upon a large funeral procession. The only son of a widow is being carried out. Jesus, filled with pity for the grieving mother, tells her not to weep. He then touches the coffin and tells the young man to arise. With that, the dead man gets up and starts speaking. The crowd, amazed at what they have just witnessed, praise God, saying, “A great prophet has arisen in our midst” and “God has visited his people.” This is reminiscent of what we hear in today’s First Reading from 1 Kings when the prophet Elijah raised from the dead the only son of a widow. The woman’s response is recognition of Elijah as a prophet, a man of God: “It is truly the word of the LORD that you speak.” For all these people, at this point in time, Jesus is a great prophet doing wonders and speaking in the name of God. Even John the Baptist sent his followers to listen to Jesus and report back to him. John’s question was: “Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?” (Luke 7:19) The time for the full revelation of Jesus’ person and his mission is yet to come.
